

Mark 10:1-52

- A. The Question about Divorce (10:1-12).
 - 1. Context of Questions.
 - 2. Sanctity of marriage.
 - 3. It takes two.

- B. Blessing the Children (10:13-16).
 - 1. Children: Openness to receiving the reign of God.
Adults: Sometimes a little more close minded or control conscious.

- C. Keep your Focus (10:17-31).
 - 1. Where do our blessings come from?
 - 2. Stewardship—how do we manage what God has blessed us with.

- D. Mission: To Serve Not to be Served (10:32-45).
 - 1. The Third Prediction of Jesus Suffering and Resurrection (vv.32-34). This prediction is the only passage in Mark that tells us why Jesus must die.
 - 2. Humility—Servant of the Lord.
 - 3. Leadership: leading by example.

- E. “I once was blind but now I see.” (10:46-52).
 - 1. What do you want from me?
 - a. The disciples wanted to sit on the thrones next to Jesus. (Disciples think Jesus brings Mastery and Glory).
 - b. Bartimaeus sat in the dust and wanted to see. (Bartimaeus thinks Jesus brings healing and sight).
