

Mark 6:1-56

A. Jesus' Identity (vv. 1-6a).

1. *Tekton* “carpenter” translated—handyman who could work with wood, metal, or stone.
2. Must be careful not to evaluate people merely by human criteria; c.f. 2 Cor. 4:6-12.

B. The Mission of the Disciples (vv. 6b-13).

1. Totally dependent upon God.
2. Acceptance and Rejection.
3. Repentance First.

C. The Death of John the Baptist (vv. 14-29).

1. How does Israel deal with God's prophets; The sad state of corruption Jesus and the disciples battling.

D. Return of the Disciples (vv. 6:30).

E. The Good Shepherd (vv. 31-44).

1. Rest.
2. Meeting the needs of the flock spiritually and physically.

F. Walking on the Water (vv. 45-56).

1. Purpose of Miracles—strengthen faith—revealing the identity and purpose of God in Jesus Christ.
